Procedure for Creation of Projects

Semesters projects are created in the 2nd or 3rd week of the semester.

 This is to allow for typical adjustments to the schedule of classes during the first couple of weeks of the semester.

Campus Policies/Procedures

Courses that are 70 days or shorter:

- Faculty QP tasks begin 21 days before the Class-End and end one week later. (faculty have one week to create their personalized questions)
- Student FO tasks begin at the end of the QP task. Which means 2 weeks before the final week begins and ends before the final week starts.) (Students have one weeks to do their evals)
- Faculty SVM tasks starts at the same time and FO task, and ends at the end of the class + 7 days. (so the faculty have about 3 weeks to look at their response rate)

Courses that are longer than 70 days:

- Faculty QP tasks begin 28 days before the Class-End and end one week later. (faculty have one week to create their personalized questions)
- Student FO tasks begin immediately after QP ends, and lasts for 2 weeks and end before the final week begins (students have 2 weeks to complete their evals)
- Faculty SVM tasks start at the same time as FO task, and end one week after the end of class (so the faculty have 4 weeks to look at their response rate).

Policies regarding Student Requests

- Student requests to complete the evaluation during the "final week" are not accepted.
- Student requests related to system or human error issues are addressed on case by case basis:
 - I did not receive any emails from the system
 - I prematurely submitted my evaluation
 - I completed the "wrong evaluation" for the class or instructor
- If Academic affairs determines that the request is reasonable/credible, then the student's evaluation is "unsubmitted", allowing him/her to log back in and complete the evaluation.

Procedure for <u>Distributing Reports</u>

Creation of Reports:

- Semester project ends about 10 to 14 days after semester end-date.
- Two types of reports are generated (QP and Non-QP).
 - The QP reports are for faculty-eyes only.
 - Non-QP are for administrators (Chairs, deans, etc.)

Campus Threshold:

Reports are only generated for courses that have 3 or more responses.

Auditing of Reports:

- An initial high-level audit is done to check for general number of reports being generated, check for newly added departmental and school-level questions, check for overall changes to report formats, etc.
- Academic Affairs then distributes the reports to academic units
- Academic units then perform a more detailed audit and distribute the reports to their faculty. At this point departments may apply additional policies (such as dept. minimum thresholds, etc.) if they wish.

Policies regarding Small Classes

- Small classes larger than 3 students should take affirmative measures to encourage students to complete the course evaluations. (e.g., required assignment, with or without credit)
- Classes smaller than 3 students will not receive a report. Possible solutions:
 - department conduct its own survey
 - combine similar sections in to a larger "shadow section", then have the larger section evaluated.

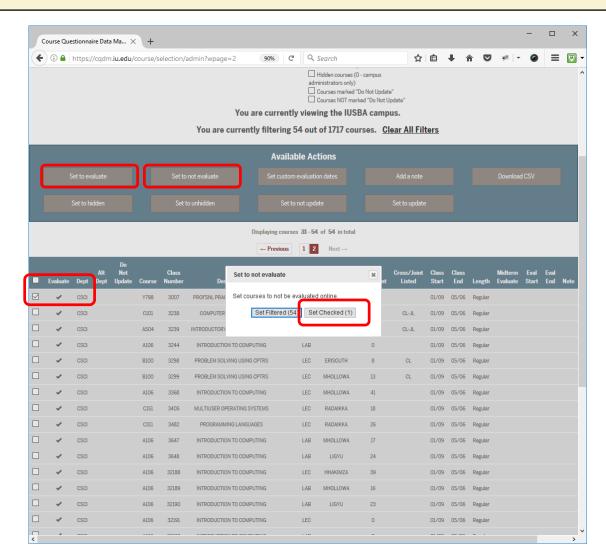


Depending on your access rights, you can pick a department



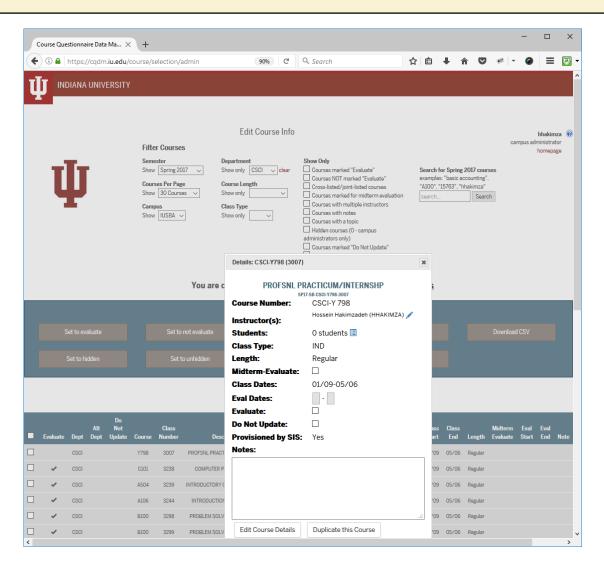


Pick which courses should be Evaluated or Not Evaluated

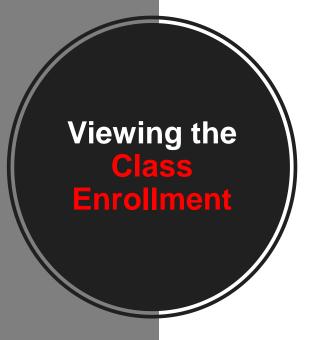


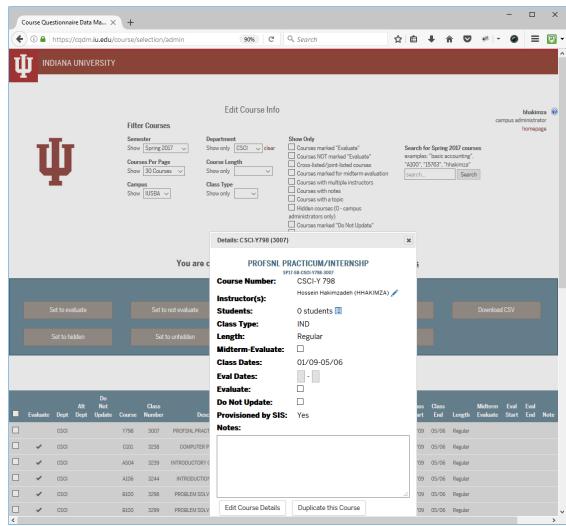




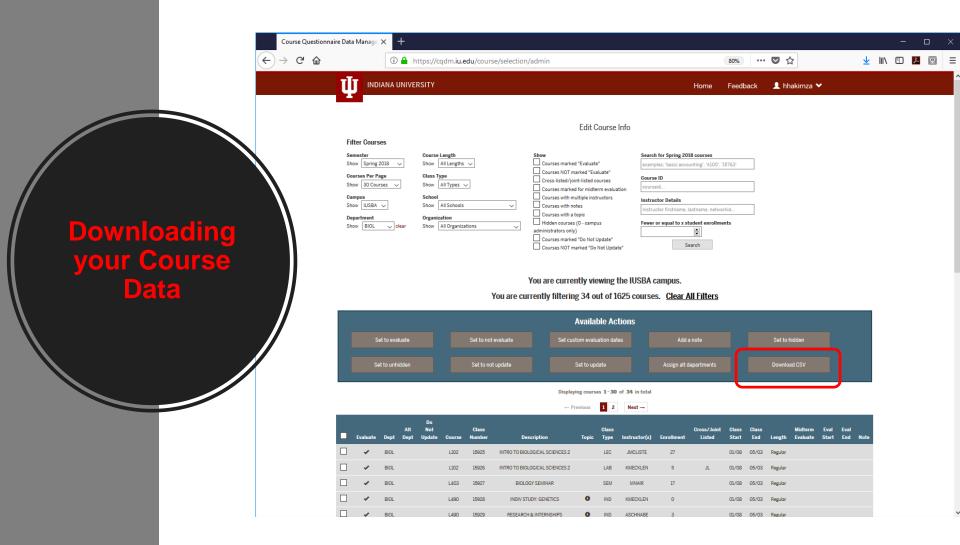




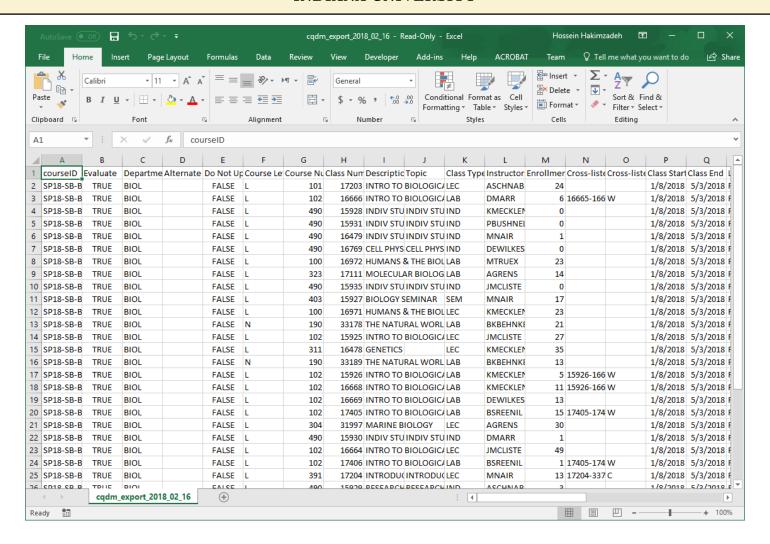
