## **Exam Information**

- This placement exam guides IU South Bend students to enroll in either CSCI-B 100/INFO-I 101 or CSCI-C101/INFO-I 210. If
  you have completed AP CSP or AP CSA or other programming courses successfully, contact a Computer Science or
  Informatics advisor before taking the placement exam. Email: info@cs.iusb.edu
- Total Time Allowed: 90 minutes
- Total Questions: 48 [70 points]
  - Multiple choice and True/False questions from the following topics
    - [5 Questions] General programming and problem solving concepts
    - [7 Questions] Variables and Constants (integer, float, character, string); Data Types; Input (get) and Output (print)
    - [5 Questions] Arithmetic and Relational Operators (+, -, /, \*, MODULO, >, <, >=, <=, ==, <>,!=, Integer Division)
    - [4 Questions] Boolean (AND, OR, NOT) operators and expressions
    - [7 Questions] Selection Structures (if, if-else, if-elseif, switch (case, break))
    - [7 Questions] Repetition Structures (while, for, do while)
    - [8 Questions] Algorithm and Flowchart
      - Ability to read and interpret pseudocode
      - Ability to write algorithms/pseudocode
    - [3 Questions] Arrays (1 dimension, 2 dimension) simple data structures
    - [2 Questions] functions/procedures (input, output, parameters, arguments, purpose, return)
- Aids: It's a closed test (NO aids allowed. No books, notes, laptops, smart phones, calculators, other electronic devices, etc.)
- Results : Students who place at
  - Level 1: Take CSCI-B 100 or INFO-I 101
  - Level 2: Take CSCI-C 101 or INFO-I 210
    - Placing at this level does not provide credits to CSCI-B 100 or INFO-I 101 nor waives the course to satisfy general education or other requirements.

## **Exam Scheduling**

- This is a placement exam pilot and it cannot be repeated, and can be taken only once.
- The fee for this exam is \$15. This fee is currently waived and students need not pay a fee. But this could change anytime, so please check with the proctoring center while scheduling your appointment.
